### CONDITIONS

- 1. Work shall include surface preparation, placement of asphalt and aggregate chips, required sweeping until minimal loose aggregate remains.
- 2. 3/8-inch black granite aggregate chips shall be placed as the first coat of the parking lot. ¼" black granite aggregate chips be placed for the surface coat.
- 3. Sweeping of aggregate shall begin no sooner than three days and no later than 7 days after placement. All roads shall be swept at least two to three times until there is minimal loose aggregate on the roadway surface.
- 4. Contractor is responsible for all traffic control during the chip-sealing process.
- 5. Pavement Marking paint shall be white for standard parking stalls and blue for accessible parking stalls. The quantities listed for the accessible stalls is for straight lines unit price shall include cost for marking the standard ACCESSIBLE PARKING Symbol in each stall and "VAN" on each van accessible stall
- **6.** The attached site plan shows approximate locations of proposed stalls. The Owner will provide a final pavement marking layout for the lot prior to marking.
- Contract shall provide at least two-weeks' notice before the start of work and shall place signs
  indicating that "CHIP SEAL WILL BEGIN WEEK OF \_\_\_\_\_" and shall be placed at the entrance
  to the parking lot.
- 8. No work shall be performed unless there is 40% or less chance of rain and the air temperature is at least 60 degrees and rising.
